  - Miss Mary brought up an idea to go door-to-door for tax-credits. We decided that maybe finding relatives, friends, etc. and educating them about the tax-credit might be helpful. We can ask for the donations be designated for LTCS. Also let everyone know that they can donate as little as \$5 up to \$200/\$400. Discussed having a push both currently, and in the Spring after tax refunds.
  - Discussed reward for classroom with the most BoxTops; an extra recess with fruit pops. Also discussed that BoxTops must be turned in twice a year.
  - Discussed needing to educate the community about different fundraising ideas.
  - Discussed AZ Savings book. Need to pick up books from Beth that were sold. Also, need to continue to advertise that AZ Savings Books can still be purchased online with monies going towards LTCS.
